II-Read the text.

Robert Louis Stevenson was an author from Scotland who wrote many famous books, including *Treasure Island* and *Kidnapped*.

He was born on 13th November, 1850, in Edinburgh, which is the capital of Scotland. He studied Law at Edinburgh University. However, he never worked as a lawyer because he wanted to be an author.

His first book, which was called *An Inland Voyage*, was published in 1878. It was about his travels to Antwerp in France.

He got the idea for *Treasure Island* when he drew a treasure map for his 12-year-old son. He wrote an adventure story about the map, which was about pirates looking for treasure. The story appeared in a

magazine for boys before it was published as a book in 1883. Treasure Island was very popular and Robert became very successful.

Although he was doing very well in his job in the 1880s, Robert wasn't very well. In 1888, he and his family travelled around the Pacific islands until they finally decided to settle down and live in the Samoan Islands. He continued to write stories until his death there in 1894.
